MUSIC & MOVEMENT CLASS FOR YOUNG CHILDREN

A music and movement class for children aged 4 months – 4 years will begin **Wednesday, January 9th at 1:30 PM**. The class will run for 8 weeks (Jan. 9th – Feb. 27th), be held in the library at PCC, and be taught by Colleen Millett.

The class is based on the world renowned MusikGarten curriculum and includes songs, rhymes, movement, stories, age-appropriate instruments, and more. (Older siblings are very welcome to attend, but will be expected to be helpers and role models!)

Colleen taught with MusikGarten and other curricula at the Preschool of the Arts in Tolland, CT and is very excited to share with families at PCC.

The class costs \$15 per child. That fee covers a set of instruments for your child. The \$15 fee will be due before the first class on Jan. 9th.
