## Notes for the Preaching of God's Word

### Rest & The Word of God

Hebrews 4:1-13

Main Preaching Point: Strive to enter the rest of God, through faith in the gospel of God, by opening your heart to the Word of God

- The *rest* of God is his good news (gospel) to us (4:1-3)
- Warning and Hope in God's rest—perspective from Ps.95
  - Looking at the Past—the wilderness generation (3:16-4:3)
  - Looking at the Future—perspective from Psalm 95 (4:7-8)
- Striving to enter God's rest by faith—"the already but not yet" (4:3,9-11)
- The Word of God—the X-ray of the heart (4:12-13)

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Questions for Individuals, families, or small groups

Text: Hebrews 4:1-13

Title: Rest & The Word of God

Questions:

1. What was most important or applicable in today's preaching? Can you summarize the main message?

**The *rest* of God is his good news (gospel) to us (4:1-3)**

2. Read Hebrews 4:1-3. According to the verses (and the sermon) how is God's rest referred to as good news?

3. What defines the rest that is mentioned throughout the whole passage? How is it related to the gospel/good news (v.2)?

- How does the author use God's rest on the 7<sup>th</sup> day to describe the rest that is offered to the church? Explain.

We are warned, lest we fail to enter His rest—perspective from the Old Testament

4. Read Hebrews 3:16-4:3. How does the author use the wilderness generation as a warning? (for further reading, see Deuteronomy 1:19-35 & Numbers 14:26-30). Explain.

- What does the author mean by "fear" in 4:1? Discuss.
- According to the sermon and text, what is the fundamental reason a person would miss the gospel-rest that is offered (v.3:19)? What is the difference and relationship between unbelief (3:19) and disobedience (4:6)? Explain.

5. Read Heb.4:7-8. How does the author use Psalm 95 (written by David long after Joshua led God's people into the promised land) to speak of another day—a future rest for God's people? Why is this important?

**Striving to enter God's rest by faith—"the already but not yet" (4:3, 9-11)**

6. Read Hebrews 4:3, 9-11. How do these verses speak of both, a present rest as well as a future rest for the true people of God? In what way(s) have God's people "already" entered His rest? In what way(s) have God's people "not yet" entered His rest? Discuss.

- What is meant by this term "already, but not yet"? Why is it important? In what way(s) is the author of Hebrews using the wilderness generation to describe our present circumstance in this world? Why is this important?

**The Word of God—the X-ray of the heart (4:12-13)**

7. Read Hebrews 4:12-13. What role does the Word of God play in this passage and context? Explain.

- What is Word described as doing? Read 1 Peter 1:23, 1 Thess.2:13, Jer.23:29, for further consideration.
- What role is the Word of God playing in your life? Discuss the following statement: 'we are not called to master the Word, but to allow the Word to master us'
