#### TAKE THEM A MEAL

One joy that we have as a church family is to encourage one another and share out of the abundance that God has given us. As needs arise, the PCC Women's Team will be posting weekly the names of folks who would benefit from a prepared meal. To help meet a need is simple and may be done one of 2 ways: a) Go to [takethemameal.com](http://takethemameal.com), enter the family's last name in the FIND box, and 2540 as the password for any PCC need. The resulting screen will reveal all the info needed for the family you requested including where to deliver the meal, special dietary needs, dates needed, etc. You choose a date and enter your name and email. There is also a place to describe the meal you are taking so that others can avoid preparing the same foods. The site will send you a reminder near the date you signed up for and an email to the recipients about the meal you are delivering. b) Call Cecelia Clark and let her know that you would like to help, and she will enter the information for you on the web site. Any needs that you know of should be passed on to your shepherding elder, Walt Mayo, or Danielle Bolliger in the church office who will then get the information to the PCC Women's Team. **Remember** that meals do not have to be elaborate! Just prepare a little extra of what you are making for your family or pick up a rotisserie chicken, pizza, etc. and add a salad to go with.
